HLTFA302A – PROVIDE FIRST AID IN REMOTE SITUATION

Program Overview

DO YOU WORK ALONE OR ARE ISOLATED? This unit of competency describes the skills and knowledge required to provide first aid to a casualty in a remote and/or isolated situation.

Pre-requisites/Co-requisites

Students are required to have completed HLTFA301B - Apply First Aid or Senior First Aid. This unit should be assessed either after or in conjunction with achievement of HLTFA301B - Apply First Aid.

Award

On successful completion of the course, the participant will receive a Statement of Attainment, which is valid for three years. As per the Australian Resuscitation Council guidelines the HLT CPR201A - Perform CPR unit needs to be completed annually.

Elements

- Prepare to respond to emergency in a remote situation
- Provide First Aid in a remote situation
- Work in conjunction with medical and emergency services support
- Evaluate the incident

Delivery

This program is delivered over nine hours. The delivery mode is available in a workshop style outdoors practical.

Assessment Strategy

Assessment is both formative and summative, with practical and realistic assessment situations. Students must demonstrate competency in all sections to qualify for a Statement of Attainment. A Theory Assessment is to be completed prior to attendance on the practical phase of the training this can be completed either on-line or via a workbook requiring satisfactory completion of all questions.

Skills in performing first aid procedures will be assessed through the **demonstration** of correct procedures, followed by **questioning**, to confirm essential knowledge. They will take place in a range of situations relevant to the workplace or community setting.
